This month's selections highlight the small, handcrafted, quality wines of the Pacific Northwest along with a crisp, refreshing, sparkling rose from Loire Valley, France.

- Touraine Sparkling Rose, Thomas, FR 40
 From one of the best producers in the Loire Valley--rosé from 100% gamay. Light strawberry / raspberry flavors with a light, delicate mousse.
- '09 Bergevin Lane Viognier, Columbia Valley, WA 36
 Viognier - an overlooked white varietal. Barrel fermented with well integrated oak- this is a full bodied version on the tropical side. Floral on the nose, melon, pear, citrus and vanilla on the palate.
- '06 L'Ecole No 41 "Fries Vineyard" Semillon, WA 36
 If you enjoy full bodied chardonnay, you'll enjoy this ripe and pungent, rich, fruit driven mix of fig, peach and melon. A long dry finish with just a hint of barrel influence. 91pts WA
- '07 Silvan Ridge Reserve Merlot, Rogue Valley, OR 50
 A big, full bodied merlot from this little known AVA in southern Oregon. Rich red and black fruit flavors dominate the palate with soft silky tannins on the finish.

Beer

Einbecker Non-Alcoholic 6.00

From Germany, a standout in non-alcoholic beers. Brewed in the pilsener style-- a light body, golden hue with a sophisticated style.

Michelob Ultra 4.95

Light golden color, low-carb American style lager with subtle citrus. Clean and refreshing.

Kronenbourg 1664 6.50

Founded in 1664 this is a crisp, premium lager by France's dominant beer brand. Made with strisselspalt hops, an aromatic variety exclusive to Alsace.

Weinenstephener Hefe-Weizen 6.50

The world's oldest working brewery—dating back to 1040. Wheat beers now account for 25% of Germany's beer production. Crisp, refreshing citrus, hints of clove, with a lively, effervescent head of foam.

Castalain Blonde Ale (750ml) 19.50

A "bierre de garde," which means a beer to store. Traditionally made in the fall and spring to be drunk in the summer. A slightly stronger, but lightly colored ale from northern France with citrus and a clean finish.

Ommegang Rare VOS 7.50

Belgium style amber-ale from Cooperstown, NY. Rare VOS is named after the Brussels bar famous for the starting point for bicycle and pigeon races. Medium colored, with aromas and flavors of caramel, orange, hops, plus an elusive, fruity-yeasty flavor!

Wychwood Hobgoblin 6.50

A strong, dark ale brewed by the UK's largest producer of organic ales. Full bodied and well balanced with a chocolate, toffee malt flavor. Moderate bitterness and a distinctive fruity character with a ruby red glow.

McAuslan St. Ambrose Oatmeal Stout 7.50

From Montreal Canada's award winning brewery. The addition of oats add a soft creaminess with a hint of cookielike nuttiness to this black stout. Well hopped with dominant flavors of espresso and chocolate.
